

Mathematics

Year 1 – We will be starting the term learning about place value of numbers up to 20. We will then learn about adding and subtracting larger numbers.

Year 2 – We will be learning about multiplication and division to start the term and then moving onto using that knowledge with fractions.

PSHE

This term we will be looking at our Aspirations, Dreams and Goals. Discussing perseverance, determination, dealing with challenge and realistic goals.

English

We will start the term learning about writing letters – Year 1 will learn to use description and conjunctions. Year 2 will be learning to use a range of punctuation in their writing. We will be using the book 'Dear Greenpeace' to help us with this.

After that, we will be writing stories that are set in a familiar place. For this we will be using the story The Tiger who came to tea. We will immerse ourselves in the story before writing our own.

History

We will be learning to investigate what our village was like on the past. We will use a range of sources to discover how and why our world is wonderful thanks to the past. We will be learning about what houses and schools were like in the past. We may even be reenacting a Victorian school day...

D&T

We will be designing and making a pouch using joining and decorating techniques. We will be cutting, gluing and sewing fabrics.

P.E.

We will be learning to create, assess, improve and perform gymnastics routines. We will be perfecting our travelling and jumping skills.

Religious Education

This term we will be learning about what it means to be a Muslim. We will be learning where Muslims worship? Be able to recognise and describe the significance of particular objects and places to Muslims.

Science
